# **EMERGENCY INFORMATION**

Dear Parents,

Our schools underwent safety checks after the earthquake in October 1989. We also have been in touch with the Civil Defense and Red Cross in Santa Clara County. Many parents have asked where the children would be evacuated to in the event of a large quake.

It is a Red Cross Policy to keep the schools open. The Red Cross will come to the schools and tell us where the children will be evacuated to, <u>if necessary</u>. They would use the nearest evacuation location. There would be a notice posted on our school's door by the Red Cross as to the place of evacuation.

All of our schools are equipped with transistor radios and flashlights and are checked monthly for good batteries. After the shaking, we will not use the telephone except to report medical or fire emergencies.

Our staff is instructed to stay with the students until the parents/guardians are able to pick them up. We will follow regular sign-out procedures.

We are asking parents/guardians to designate one family member/friend that would be able to pick up your child on feet if roads were closed. Please complete the bottom portion of this form.

### Student iPad Acceptable Use Policy Agreement

This iPad Acceptable Use Policy is intended to promote responsible use and protect students and the school from liability resulting from any misuse of the school-issued iPad. Technology, on or off-campus, must comply with our Acceptable Use Policy for Technology as stated in the West Valley Middle School Handbook. Teachers may set additional requirements for use in their respective classes.

The iPad remains the property of WVMS at all times. Therefore, there is no assumption of privacy. WVMS reserves the right to inspect student iPads and content at any time during the school year. Misuse of the iPad may result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.

Above all, the iPad program at WVMS is an academic program, and the policies governing the use of the iPad support its academic use. To maintain the integrity of the iPad program, all students and parents/guardians must acknowledge and agree to the following conditions of use.

### I. iPad Distribution and Care

- 1. The iPads issued to students are the property of WVMS and are made available to them as learning tools.
- 2. Students will be issued iPads at the beginning of the academic year. The iPads are to be returned at the end of each year for updates and routine maintenance or earlier if a student no longer attends WVMS.
- Students are responsible for purchasing and maintaining the protective case. WVMS approved iPad cases: OtterBox Defender Series Case with Screen Protector or a similar type of case. Your iPad type will be given to you before the beginning of the school year.
- 4. Students are responsible for knowing how to properly operate and protect their iPads. This includes: not leaving the iPad in a location where it can be damaged by color, heat, or moisture, and cleaning the screen with a soft, dry, or anti-static cloth, as well as keeping it in its protective case.
- Students/parents are solely responsible for the care and security of student iPads. iPads must never be left in an unlocked locker, unlocked car, or any other unsupervised area.
- 6. If the iPad is damaged or malfunctions, students must take the iPad to the office as soon as possible for evaluation. If a student damages the iPad (outside of reasonable wear and tear), the students/parents are responsible for the expense of repairing or replacing the device. This includes screen repair costs for cracked screens. The total replacement cost of an iPad & case if lost or damaged is approximately \$620-\$700.
- 7. If the iPad is lost or stolen, the student must report the incident to the Office as soon as possible. In the case of theft, the student must also file a police report. The students/parents are responsible for replacing the lost or stolen iPad at his/her own cost.
- 8. Students/parents are not permitted to repair, alter, modify, or replace iPads without the express authorization of WVMS. Under no circumstance will WVMS replace or repair a student iPad without the required payment from the student/parent.
- 9. If a student's iPad is undergoing repair, they are still accountable for preparing for class and completing all assignments, unless there has been an agreement with the teachers or administrative office.
- iPads must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels that are not the property of WVMS and approved by the WVMS
  administration.

### il. General Expectations

- 1. Students are responsible for understanding and adhering to all Acceptable Use Policy for Technology regulations from the WVMS handbook in regards to the use of technology, including this iPad agreement.
- Students may not remove or circumvent the management system installed on each iPad. This includes removing restrictions or "jail-breaking" the device.
- 3. Students may only connect to the Internet via the wireless network provided by WVMS while on campus and at their home Wi-Fi. It is the parents' responsibility to monitor the students' iPad use for acceptable sites while not on the WVMS campus.
- 4. Students are permitted to take the iPad home. However, students are expected to have fully charged iPads at school each day.

  Note: students may not have the opportunity to charge the iPads at school. Students who forget their iPads or do not bring their iPad fully charged will be considered unprepared for class and subject to the teacher's policy.
- 5. Students who leave their iPads at home are responsible for getting their coursework completed as if they had their iPad present. This is not an excuse for not completing homework, projects, etc. on time.
- The sound must be muted at all times unless permission is obtained from the teacher for instructional purposes.
- 7. iPads must always be within the approved protective cases provided by the student/parent.
- 8. iPads used by the students must bear the student's username. No other name is acceptable. Students may not remove or alter the "asset tag" located on the iPad. The "find my iPhone/iPad" function must also be on at all times.

### III. Apps, Files, Etc.

- 1. Students are expected to back up all educational work on the iPad. WVMS does not take responsibility for any lost data.
- Students should make every effort to print school work while at home. Students are not always able to print from their iPads on campus.
- 3. During the school day, earphones may only be used in the library. Permission may be given for use of earphones in a classroom by a teacher.
- 4. Educational Apps will be provided by the school. The software/apps originally installed by WVMS must remain on the iPad in usable condition and be easily accessible at all times. WVMS may add software applications throughout the year.
- 5. Students are not permitted to add any Apps or personal data (i.e. photos, movies, videos, or other personal entertainment) to the iPads without WVMS staff approval.
- 6. As stated in the Acceptable Use Policy for Technology, students must refrain from using social media, gaming, or blogging websites on the school-issued iPad. Students should not receive pop-up or email notifications from Facebook or other social network/entertainment sites or apps on the school-issued iPad.
- 7. The iPad camera may only be used when assigned by a teacher for educational purposes. When assigned, students may not distribute, publish, post, email, or share images and/or videos of students, WVMS personnel, or the campus beyond the scope of the assignment. Photos or video taken with the iPad for academic assignments must conform to the mission of WVMS.

### IV. Prohibited Use

- 1. Leaving the iPad unattended on campus.
- 2. Exchanging iPads with another student.
- 3. Allowing other students to retain or remove the iPad from their presence.
- 4. Copying certain Internet materials or reproducing or transmitting materials without the permission of the author or other right-holder.
- 5. Plagiarizing academic materials. It is the student's responsibility to respect and adhere to all copyright, trademark, and other intellectual rights and trade secrets laws.
- 6. Using the iPad for any action that violates existing school rules or public law.
- 7. Creating, accessing, or distributing offensive, profane, bullying/threatening, pornographic, obscene, rumors/gossip, sexually explicit, or other content not aligned with the school's mission and philosophy.
- 8. Use of chat rooms or messaging services not authorized by the teacher for academic use.
- 9. Accessing sites selling term papers, book reports, and other forms of student work.
- 10. Spamming: sending mass or inappropriate emails.
- 11. Gaining access to other students' accounts, files, and/or data.
- 12. Use of the school's Internet/email accounts for financial or commercial gain or for any illegal activity.
- 13. Bypassing the WVMS web filter through a web proxy.
- 14. Sharing passwords, addresses, or other personal information on the Internet without the authorization of a parent or school representative.
- 15. Taking or sharing pictures or videos of students or staff without their permission.
- 16. Using or possessing hacking software.

### V. Precautions

Children Clamphing

- 1. Students are responsible for backing up their own data in case of our network crashing.
- 2. In consideration for receiving the iPad from WVMS, each student and his or her parent or legal guardian agrees not to sue and hereby releases, waives, discharges, holds harmless, indemnifies, and defends WVMS, as well as their respective employees, personnel, staff, volunteers, agents, directors, affiliates, and representatives from any and all liability, losses, damages, claims, actions, and causes of action of every nature for any and all known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, bodily or personal injuries, property damage, or other loss, whether claimed by the student, parent, legal representative, or any third party, relating in any way to the use of the iPad furnished by WVMS to the student.

This iPad Acceptable Use Policy applies to WVMS students at all times, whether or not the students are on campus, as WVMS students are school representatives at all times.
